- I. FIRST, WHY DO WE FIND OURSELVES IN A VALLEY?
- A. A valley might mean that God sent us there—Exo, 14:1-4.
 - B. A valley may mean that we messed up somewhere.
 - C. Some valleys may never have a reason.
- II. SECOND, HOW SHOULD WE RESPOND TO VALLEY'S?
- A. Don't look for a short-cut out of your valley.
 - B. If your valley is a self-made mess then do these two things.
 - 1. One, accept the consequences—Heb. 12:7.
 - 2. Two, change directions.
 - C. Don't run because God may be trying to teach you something.
 - D. Do the right thing—I Peter 4:19.
 - E. Trust God for two reasons.
 - 1. First, every miracle needs a mess.
 - 2. Two, without a mess, God doesn't have much reason to show up.
- III. TWO WORDS OF CAUTION ABOUT VALLEYS.
- A. If you think every valley is a wrong turn you will never step out on faith.
 - B. If you run from every valley, then, you'll never experience God's miraculous power.
