I. WHAT REASONS DO WE HAVE FOR BELIEVING THE VIRGIN BIRTH?

- A. It was <u>predicted</u> in the Old Testament--<u>Isaiah 7:14--...The virgin will conceive</u> and give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel.
 - 1. Prophecies often have <u>dual</u> meanings (for that day and for a future day, too).
 - 2. The Hebrew word "almah," although, not the normal word for virgin, never is used to refer to a <u>married woman</u> (Isaiah 7:14).
- B. It was reported in the New Testament--Matthew 1:18-20; Luke 1:34-35.
- C. It was claimed by Jesus who often referred to Himself as God's Son.

II. SECOND, WHAT ARE THE RESULTS OF THE VIRGIN BIRTH?

- A. First, because of it, we know of Jesus' <u>preexistence</u> --John 1:1;14).
- B. Second, because of it we know of Jesus' <u>sinless</u> nature that made Him a worthy sacrifice for our sins--Psalm 51:5; 2 Corinthians 5:21.
- C. Third, because of it we know Jesus is the Messiah and Savior—Luke 2:11.
- D. Fourth, because of it, we experience God's <u>presence</u> in our lives--Matthew 1:23
