

**HOW TO BRING OUT THE BEST IN OTHERS**

**I. FIRST, LEADERS BRING OUT THE BEST BY ENCOURAGING PEOPLE.**

- A. Some people, though, confuse encouragement with criticism.
  
- B. How do you encourage someone to do their best?
  - 1. First, point out what they're doing right.
  
  - 2. Second, tell them what their future looks like.
  
  - 3. Third, offer to help them fine tune their strategy.
  
  - 4. Fourth, Scripture also reminds us one of the best ways to bring out the best in others is to encourage them--Isa. 35:3-4.

**II. SECOND, LEADERS BRING OUT THE BEST BY BEING AN EXAMPLE FOR OTHERS.**

- A. This is the principle of leadership Paul used--1 Cor. 11:1.
  
- B. How do leaders lead by example?
  - 1. First, leaders don't just say do as they say.
  
  - 2. Second, leaders aren't afraid to share their own mistakes and failures.
  
  - 3. Third, leaders hold themselves to the same standard.
  
  - 4. Fourth, leaders pay the price of bringing out the best in themselves.
