

BECOMING A PERSON AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART

I. A PERSON AFTER GOD'S HEART LOVES GOD'S WORD.

- A. David loved God's Word as he often said in the 73 Psalms attributed to his pen
 - 1. David may not have written Psalms 119 but he could have--Psalm 119
 - 2. Why would he say he loved God's law?
 - a. It protects from sin—119:11.
 - b. It lifts us up during trials—119:50.
 - c. It gives us peace—119:165.
- B. Jesus loved God's Word too—Matt. 4:4.
- C. Do we?—Psa. 1:1-3.

II. SECOND, A PERSON AFTER GOD'S HEART LOVES TO PRAY.

- A. David loved to pray—116:1-2.
- B. Jesus loved to pray—Luke 5:16.
- C. What about us?—1 Thess. 5:17.

III. THIRD, A PERSON AFTER GOD'S HEART PRAISES OR WORSHIPS HIM.

- A. David continually praised and worshipped God—119:164 and 104:33.
- B. Of course, Jesus did too—Matt. 11:25; 26:30.
- C. What about us?—Psa. 147:1.

IV. A PERSON AFTER GOD'S HEART FOLLOWS THROUGH.

- A. One reason David was a man after God's own heart is explained by God Himself—Acts 13:22.
- B. Jesus also did everything His Father wanted him to do—John 4:34.
- C. What about us?—Matt. 7:21.
