I. FIRST, DAVID SPOKE ABOUT SURRENDERING TO GOD.

- A. David called everyone who had any position of leadership together because he wanted them all to hear his final words—28:1.
- B. One of the first things he acknowledged is that he was where he was in life because of God—28:4.
- C. In these opening lines, King David also shared his greatest disappointment in life—28:2.
- D. Why was this is greatest disappointment? Because God told David no—28:3.

II. SECOND, DAVID SHARED GODLY ADVICE WITH HIS SON.

- A. David had not always given his children godly advice or any advice for that matter—1 Kings 1:6.
- B. Perhaps now because he is older or wiser or both he now gives godly advice to Solomon who would soon follow him to the throne—28:9-10.
- C. If you could share some final words with your kids what would you say?
- D. Listen to the godly advice David shared with his son—28:20.

III. THIRD, DAVID SANG GOD'S PRAISES.

- A. George Handel wrote what we call today, "Handel's Messiah" in 22 days in 1741.
- B. King David's final song was also about the greatness of God.
 - 1. First, David sang that everything belongs to God—29:10-11.
 - 2. Second, David sang that God comes from God—29:12.
 - 3. Third, David sang that God deserves all praise and worship—29:13.
