WHAT GOES AROUND COMES AROUND PSALMS 32:1-2 / 3-21-21 / SUN

I. HOW CAN WE <u>RECEIVE</u> FORGIVENESS?

- A. First, how can we receive forgiveness from <u>God</u>?
 - 1. The first step involves evaluating our <u>relationship</u> with God—Ps. 139.23-24.
 - 2. The second step involves acknowledging our <u>failure</u> to God—Ps. 51:4.
 - 3. The third step involves <u>receiving</u> God's forgiveness—Psa 51:1.
- B. How can we receive forgiveness from <u>others</u>?
 - 1. The bad news is other people aren't always willing to forgive us.
 - 2. How can we ask others to forgive us?
 - a. First, don't blame others.
 - b. Second, <u>identify</u> what you've done wrong and confess it.
 - c. Third, <u>ask</u> for forgiveness.
 - 3. Be prepared for a <u>negative</u> response, though.

II. HOW CAN WE GIVE FORGIVENESS TO OTHERS?

- A. Remember the reasons we've already learned to forgive others.
 - 1. Only way to settle a <u>debt</u>.
 - 2. Releases us to get on with our life.
 - 3. Required by <u>scripture</u>.
- B. What are the steps involved in forgiving others?
 - 1. First, admit that you have been <u>hurt</u>.
 - 2. Second, acknowledge the <u>debt</u> you are owed.
 - 3. Third, <u>release</u> your offender of his obligation.
