I. WE LEARN THAT MOTHER'S FOLLOW GOD'S WILL.

A. Mary said yes to God's will for her life—1:34-38.

B. This teaches us that the best mothers are committed first to God, then to their families--Matthew 22:37-38.

1. It's been said that the best thing a man can do for his children is to love their mother—Eph. 5:25 and Col. 3:19.

2. It's also true that the best thing parents can do for their children is to love God.

3. Timothy had a mother and a grandmother who he knew loved God—2 Timothy 1:5.

II. SECOND, FROM MARY WE LEARN THAT MOMS AREN'T PERFECT.

A. We see that despite the fact Mary was the mother of Jesus, she wasn't perfect--John 2:1-5.

B. Paul acknowledges that parents aren't perfect too—Eph. 6:4.

III. THIRD, FROM MARY WE LEARN "ONCE A MOTHER, ALWAYS A MOTHER."

A. Mary illustrates this truth—Luke 2:34-35 & John 19:25.

Look to God for comfort when there's nothing else you can do—Ps. 34:18.
