**I. GOD OFTEN ASKS US TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE.**

- A. He asked others before us.
- B. Why does God ask us to do the impossible?
  - 1. To teach us to trust him.
  - 2. To demonstrate his power.
  - 3. To be glorified.
- C. Another reason God asks us to do the impossible is to draw us closer to him.

**II. GOD'S INVITATION TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE CAUSES US TO EXPERIENCE A CRISIS OF BELIEF.**

- A. What is a crisis of belief?
  - 1. The Greek word for “**crisis**” means “**judgment**”.
  - 2. It refers to a place and time when a decision or judgment must be made.
  - 3. It's a point where we demonstrate what we really believe about God.
  - 4. Our first response is almost always to doubt.
- B. Why do we doubt?
  - 1. Because God's assignments are always God-sized.
  - 2. If not, God is probably not in it.
  - 3. If we can do it without God's help, the world sees only what a committed Christian can do.

**III. HOW CAN WE TURN MISSION IMPOSSIBLE INTO MISSION POSSIBLE?**

- A. By letting go of our seats and the Bible calls this “faith”.
- B. God sometimes invites us to join him in doing things that are impossible.
