YOU'RE SPECIAL 1 PETER 2:9-10 / 8-14-19 / WED

I. FIRST, WE ARE SPECIAL <u>PEOPLE</u>.

- A. Peter was a slow <u>learner</u> when it came to understanding that Gentiles, that is, the Church, are now part of God's chosen people.
 - 1. He was reluctant to <u>witness</u> to Gentiles and God used a vision to teach him otherwise—Acts 10:15.
 - 2. He was even reluctant to <u>fellowship</u> with Gentiles and God used a personal rebuke from Paul to again teach him otherwise—Gal. 2:11-14.
 - 3. Now, however, Peter learned that Gentiles and Jews make up the Church—2:10a.

1 Peter 2:10b

...now you are the people of God...

- B. In verse 9, Peter uses four phrases to describe the benefits of being the Church of God.
 - 1. First, Christians are a chosen people—9a—"...you are a chosen people..."
 - a. In the opening verse of this letter, Peter stressed <u>election</u>—1:1—"Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to God's elect".
 - b. Now he uses this same idea again to suggest not only do we choose God but He chooses us first—Eph. 1:4 and John 1:12.
 - 2. Second, Christians are a royal <u>priesthood</u>—**9a**—**"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood...**
 - a. Peter probably had Exo. 19:6 in mind when he said this.
 - b. We saw in 2:5 this implies <u>access</u> to God and sacrifices toward God (worship and witness).
 - 3. Third, Christians are a <u>holy</u> nation—9a—"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation..."
 - a. "Holy" or" Hagious" in Greek means "different" or "special".
 - b. Jesus reminds us that we are to be different—Matt. 5:13-16.

- 4. Fourth, Christians <u>belong</u> to God—**9a—"But you are a chosen people, a royal** priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession".
 - a. Often the value of a thing depends on who owned it.
 - b. We are valuable because we belong to God. Peter repeats this in verse 10.
 - c. We are also valuable because we received something of great value, God's mercy—

 10b—"...once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy."
 - d. Peter mentioned God's mercy earlier--1:3.
- II. SECOND, WE'RE NOT ONLY SPECIAL PEOPLE, WE HAVE A SPECIAL TASK.
 - A. The task is that—v.9b--that you may declare the praises of him...
 - B. This task is twofold-worship and witness.
- III. THIRD, WE'RE NOT ONLY SPECIAL PEOPLE WITH A SPECIAL TASK, BUT WE NOW HAVE A SPECIAL STANDING—9c— who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
 - A. Once we stood in darkness, spiritual darkness—Eph. 5:8 and John 1:5.
 - B. Now, however, Christians stand in God's wonderful light—9c and John 8:12.
