I. MOSES' LIFE.

- A. His name means “**Drawn forth, Taken out of the water.**”
- B. Moses was born in Egypt.
- C. His parents were Amram & Jochebed.
- D. Was the youngest of three children.
- E. Had one brother—Aaron.
- F. Was the grandson of Kohath.
- G. Was the great grandson of Levi.
- H. Was educated in the palace of Pharaoh.
- I. Married Zipporah, daughter of Jethro.
- J. Had two sons: • Gershom • Eliezer
- K. God spoke to him face to face—Numbers 12:7-8.

II. MOSES' _____.

- A. After Joseph's death there was 400 years of silence from God, then came Moses.
- B. Lived a total of 120 years (1526-1406 B.C.) - Deuteronomy 34:7.
- C. Spent 1st forty years in Egypt (1526-1486 B.C.) - Acts 7:22-23.
- D. Spent 2nd forty years in the land of Midian (1486-1446 B.C.) - Exodus 2:15 .
- E. Spent the final forty years leading the children of Israel through the wilderness (1446-1406 B.C.) - Deuteronomy 8:2.
- F. Wrote five books of the Bible plus the 90th Psalm—Exo. 34:27.
- G. Moses was the first person to perform miracles.
- H. Moses was the first mediator between God and men and in that sense was a Prophet.
- I. He made a mistake in the wilderness and it cost him the Promised Land—Numbers 20:9-12.
- J. On the Mount of Transfiguration Jesus was with Elijah and Moses—Matt. 17:3.
- K. Moses is mentioned in Acts 7:20-44 AND Hebrews 11:23-29.
