

YOUR DAYS ARE NUMBERED
PSALMS 90 / AUGUST 10, 2017 / PM

I. FIRST, THOSE WHO KNOW THEIR GOING TO DIE SOMEDAY, HAVE A HEART OF WISDOM.

- A. This is what Moses means in the first part of verse 12--“**Teach us to number our days**”.
- B. Do you know that someday you’re going to die?
 - 1. Moses acknowledged this in verse 10. Let me read it again.
 - 2. The older we get, like Moses, the more funerals we attend and the more we’re reminded of our own mortality.

II. SECOND, THOSE WHO ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THEIR FAMILY AND FRIENDS HAVE A HEART OF WISDOM.

- A. At the end of this Psalm, Moses talks about children and family—v. 16.
- B. We have hearts of wisdom, then, when our families come to realize and acknowledge that their days are also numbered.
- C. We want them to know that they come with expiration dates so they can have hearts of wisdom too.

III. THIRD, THOSE WHO ARE READY TO DIE HAVE HEARTS OF WISDOM.

- A. Moses says in verse 14 that knowing and receiving God’s love results in the joy of being ready to die when our expiration date is up.
- B. Do you know and have you received God’s love?
