I. WHERE IS GOD?

- A. Texans and Floridian have been sent reeling.
- B. Max Lucado asks **“Where is God in all this---**Luke 21:25; Luke 21:27-28.
- C. Lucado’s advice in all of this is to stop looking at these crises and start looking to God instead—Psa. 121:1-2.
- D. The Apostle Peter forgot how important it was to look to God instead of disasters—Matt. 14:29-31.

- B. Jesus’ disciples asked a similar question when they saw a man who had been born blind (John 9:1).

- D. Jesus addressed this same question when he was told about two other disasters—Luke 13:1-5.
