We are re-opening the church buildings June 1st. Our first Sunday Service will be on June 7th.

Below are the re-opening plans for June 7<sup>th</sup>.

- 1. Please call the office at 872-3529 to reserve seats for yourself and your family for each Sunday service, so we can ensure proper distancing. If reservations exceed our capacity, another service will be added.
- 2. Sunday morning service will begin at 11:00 am, as usual. Sunday evening services are suspended until further notice. Wednesday services will be at 6:00, adults in the sanctuary, youth in the FLC.
- 3. Please use the main doors for the sanctuary, only. All other areas of the church will remain closed.
- 4. Face masks and hand sanitizer will be available in the foyer. Face masks are optional.
- 5. Social distancing is encouraged at all times. Please, no hand shaking, hugging, etc. You may drop offerings in the offering plates on the table at the back of the sanctuary as you exit the building. Remember that you may also mail your gift or give online.
- 6. The sanctuary will reflect proper social distancing seating arrangements. Please don't come in thinking you will sit in your favorite seat.
- 7. There will be no Sunday School, child care or children's church until further notice.
- 8. All unused portions of the building will remain closed, including the children's building and Fellowship Hall.
- 9. Appointed personnel will clean and sanitize accessible parts of the building, including restrooms, before and after services.

Of course, everyone has their opinion. We ask that you honor and respect the prayerful decisions that have been made by the leadership of FBC Noble.

Please pray with us that we may lift these restrictions by the beginning of July. We will continue streaming services online. Stay tuned and stay connected.
