

STATS ON MOTHERS

Some interesting highlights from the U.S. Census Bureau's 2007 statistics concerning mothers:

Number of children the average woman can expect to have in her lifetime: 2.1

Average age of a woman when giving birth for the first time: 25.2

There are 10.4 million single mothers in the U.S. (by comparison, there were 3.7 million in 1970).

There were 5.6 million stay-at-home mothers in 2006.

Somewhere between 61 percent and 81 percent of children under the age of six eat breakfast and dinner with their mother every single day.
