Please pray about becoming a foster parent or if you know someone who would make a good foster parent, please come to this meeting.

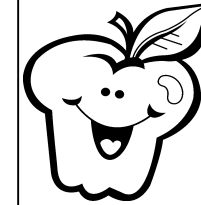
These children just need someone to love them and take care of their needs.

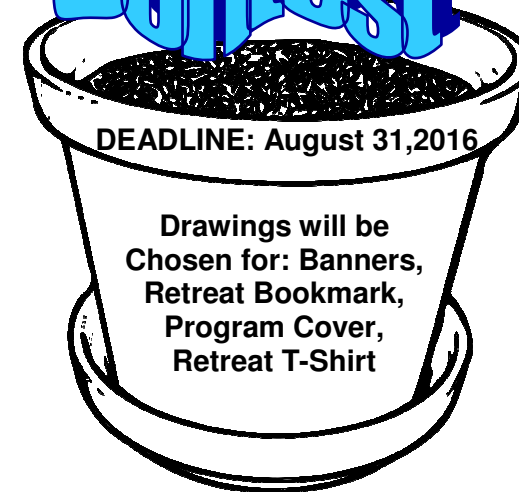
#### **Apple Festival 2016**
