²¹ For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, ²² WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH; ²³ ^[a] and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting *Himself* to Him who judges righteously; ²⁴ and He Himself ^[b] bore our sins in His body on the ^[c] cross, so that we might die to ^[d] sin and live to righteousness; for by His ^[e] wounds you were healed. ²⁵ For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and ^[f] Guardian of your souls.
