## Matthew 6:25-33

### The Cure for Anxiety

<sup>25</sup> "For this reason I say to you, <sup>[a]</sup>do not be worried about your <sup>[b]</sup>life, *as to* what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, *as to* what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? <sup>26</sup> Look at the birds of the <sup>[c]</sup>air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and *yet* your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they? <sup>27</sup> And who of you by being worried can add a *single* <sup>[d]</sup>hour to his <sup>[e]</sup>life? <sup>28</sup> And why are you worried about clothing? Observe how the lilies of the field grow; they do not toil nor do they spin, <sup>29</sup> yet I say to you that not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these. <sup>30</sup> But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is *alive* today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, *will He* not much more *clothe* you? You of little faith! <sup>31</sup> Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear for clothing?' <sup>32</sup> For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. <sup>33</sup> But <sup>[f]</sup>seek first <sup>[g]</sup>His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be <sup>[h]</sup>added to you.
