How to Get Started at MVBC

The Answer = Just start somewhere

Getting started at MVBC is easy just begin somewhere. The easiest starting point is our worship service or one of our special events. Just take the step and begin your journey. The first step is always the hardest. If you are reading this, then you have probably taken a step so continue by taking another step. Below is a list of our regular programming, all of which are great starting points.

Regular Programs at MVBC

Sundays

Sunday School @ 9:30 am – This is an age graded small group Bible study for all ages.

Worship Service @10:45 am – This is a church-wide time of worship and a message presented by our pastor or guest speaker.

Family Bible Study Gathering @ 6:00 pm – This is a small casual discussion format Bible Study for all ages where one can go deeper in Bible Study, families are encouraged to participate together.

3rd Sunday Night Fellowships @ 6:00 pm – Each 3rd Sunday of the month we have church fellowships. Every other month is a church-wide fellowship and the other month is set aside for Sunday School class fellowships. If some reason the fellowship cannot be on the 3rd Sunday it is moved to the 4th Sunday.

Children's Choir @ 6:00 pm – There are two choirs one for children completed kindergarten to 6th grade during the fall, and another for children age 3 to kindergarten.

Wednesdays

VernKids @ 6:00 pm – This is a fun learning time for children 6th grade and below. The program runs during the school year. Vans are available to pick up students.

The SHED @ 6:00 am – This is for 7th – 12th graders all year long. This is led by our youth pastor David McFerron.

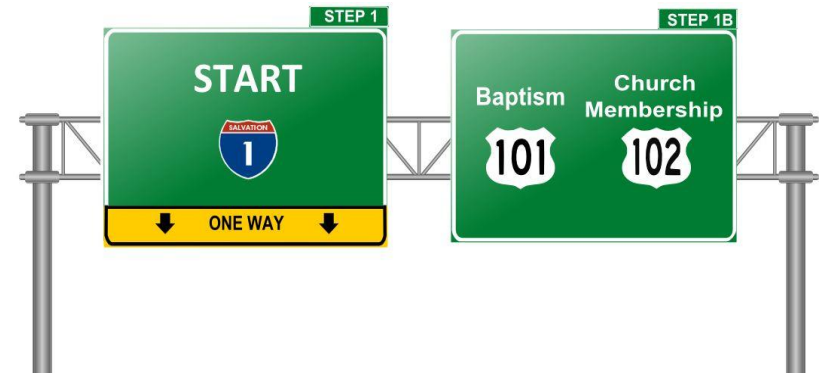
