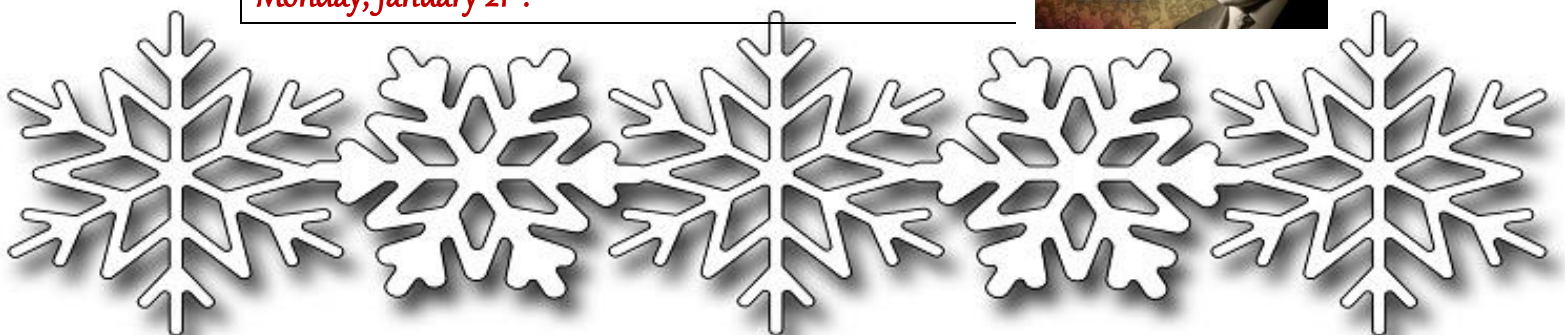
We wish a warm and Happy New Year to each of you and your families. God be with you in 2019!

COMMUNICABLE ILLNESS/CONDITION: Please inform us if your child is diagnosed as having any communicable illness/condition (i.e., chicken pox, lice, strep throat, pink eye, measles, fifth disease, etc.). We will notify the other Holy Cross families about the possible exposure.

PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT ILLNESS: If a child becomes ill at Holy Cross, we contact parents at home or at work. A child is sent home with a temperature of 100 degrees or greater, our procedure is to have the child remain home until he/she is fever-free for a minimum of 24 hours. If your child complains of not feeling well prior to leaving home in the morning, we would appreciate your cooperation by taking the time to check the complaint before sending him/her to school or child care.
