

Camp Rules

1. Have Fun!!!
2. All cell phones and electronic devices must be turned in to the Camp Director at registration.
3. Your nametag is your identification. Wear it all the time unless you are showering or involved in water activities.
4. Campers needing to see the nurse, camp pastor, or other staff member must receive permission from the adult in charge of the camper at the time (usually the team leader).
5. Permission from the Camp Director is required to leave the campgrounds.
6. Follow the schedule and be prepared.
7. Follow all instructions and safety rules for all activities.
8. Cabins are off-limits during the day unless a camper is accompanied by a team leader.
9. Campers must be in the cabins for “lights out” as designated on the schedule. Only campers with permission of team leaders may leave the cabins after lights are turned off.
10. Clothing:
 - Girls: No short shorts above fingertip length; no tops that show your bra straps or your navel. No leggings or biker shorts. No t-shirts with inappropriate messages.
 - Boys: No t-shirts with inappropriate messages or large armholes. No sagging pants. No biker shorts.
11. Be polite in your words and your actions to ALL adults and to EACH OTHER!
12. No disorderly conduct, profane language, rudeness or destructiveness will be tolerated. Any behavior, which is constantly inappropriate or violent, may result in that camper being removed from camp at the parent’s expense.
13. All campers and staff will be required to wear masks as designated by the camp directors with guidance from the county Health Department at the time of camp.
