Regular Sunday Schedule Resumes on January 10

Welcome to the new year, 2021! Governor Wolf has announced that the three-week intensive holiday COVID-19 restrictions will expire, as originally planned, on Monday January 4th. We will resume our "regular" Sunday schedule starting on January 10th with Sunday School at 9:45 AM and worship at 11:00.

We will continue to observe COVID-19 precautions for all church activities and events. Please utilize the hand-sanitizer stations, maintain appropriate social distance (members of the same household may sit together), and wear masks at all times while in the building. If you are not feeling well, or believe you may have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, or if you are not comfortable wearing a mask, *please* remain at home.

Sunday services will continue to be live-streamed via Facebook and posted on the church website for those who, for any reason, are unable to come to in-person worship.

The Adult Class meets in the Annex. On January 10 & 17, Pastor Sue will lead a discussion to wrap up the study "Glory Days" by Max Lucado. Please be sure to return any borrowed Glory Days materials to the church office by January 17. We will begin a new study on January 24.

If you are not hearing the livestream well enough and are using a smart phone, Ipad or another type of tablet (anything that uses bluetooth) – please try using a Bluetooth speaker. The Bluetooth speaker is a standalone speaker that "connects" wirelessly to your smart phone. It is easy to connect to your phone and should help you hear the service better. They are relatively inexpensive so give it a try!

There isn't much more we can do at the church to improve the volume of the audio (at least in the near term). We will need to invest in some more equipment and we are investigating the path forward. Let us know how you make out!

Highlights for Session Meeting, December 16, 2020

- The Deacons recently provided meals for the Volosins and provided prayer blankets for Leslie Stevenson and Mary Kidwell. They were able to help with rent for a community member, paid for postage for the Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes, and gave Nancy Fry a donation for her supplies in making prayer blankets this year. Thank you, Deacons, and thank you, Nancy!
- Date of the annual congregational meeting set for Sunday, February 14, 2021 after the worship service, with a tentative back-up ("snow") date of February 21, 2021. Session will further discuss ways to hold the meeting should we still be under the current ban on gatherings of more than 10 people.
- We are still looking to nominate one elder for a three-year term to complete the slate of officers.
- Bud Owen presented the proposed 2021 budget, which was approved by Session after minor changes. The budget will be presented to the congregation at the annual meeting.
- Reviewed Christmas Eve plans in light of increased COVID-19 restrictions. Reservations will be taken via phone calls and limit to 120.
- ECO National Gathering will be held January 29-31, 2021. This will be held as a virtual event and there is no cost for participation. Pastor Sue is encouraging participation in this year's gathering.
- Tom Walker made the suggestion of purchasing supplies for Community Dinners in bulk. This
 would allow more cost-efficient purchases. Janeen will look into purchasing items in bulk.
 These items will be stored and made available for the dinners as well as the Deacons providing
 meals.
- Tom Walker also reported that the Jamestown VFW donated several large cans of baked beans, green beans, mayonnaise, etc. A thank you will be sent to the VFW for their contribution.

- The next Properties, Mission, Finance committee meeting is January 20, 2021 at 5:30.
- The next Session meeting is scheduled for January 27, 2021 at 6:30.
