## Jamestown ECO Presbyterian Church Highlights of the Session Meeting, December 22, 2021

At the regular meeting of the session on December 22, 2021, all session members were present. The following information was presented and actions taken:

#### **Treasurer's Report & Finance**

- Checking balance as of November 30, 2021: \$17,676.70
- Offerings for November totaled \$7,850
- The general fund balance includes \$9,851 designated for the parking lot. Of this, \$4,851 was donated by individuals in the congregation specifically for the parking lot and \$5,000 came from budgeted general funds
- Since efforts are being redirected towards obtaining future pastoral leadership, it was MSC that the \$4851 that has been donated for the parking lot be moved to a separate designated fund for future use while the other \$5,000 will continue to remain part of the general checking account. General checking account should reflect this as a November 30 balance of \$12,825.70.

Mission: January 2022 is a five Sunday month. We will continue with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday being used

as a special disaster relief offering. For January 16 the focus will be the recent tornado

areas in the Midwest, particularly Kentucky.

**Fellowship:** Saturday Supper on January 15 – beef stroganoff; February 19 – meatloaf. Potluck luncheon for the congregational meeting on February 13

**Worship:** Reviewed plans for Christmas Eve service; lots of music this year!

**Outreach:** Planning a 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade afterschool event for Friday January 21; joined with Lutheran Village to pack 300 treat bags for Jr and Sr High students & staff.

**Preschool:** Christmas program on Dec 21<sup>st</sup> was well attended. Finances going well.

**Old Business**: Discussed progress regarding future pastoral leadership. Focus will be on obtaining a pastor to serve on a one-half time basis (Pastor Sue is at one-quarter time).

**New Business:** A special donation in the amount of \$5,000 has been received, to be used at Session's discretion. It has been decided to use these funds toward updating the pastor's office, which is currently doubling as a storage area for the Wings to Fly healthy snacks program.

Session also approved Pastor Sue's request to take one week of vacation, February 14<sup>th</sup> through 20<sup>th</sup>.

Next Session meeting: January 26 at 7:00 p.m.


