
Jamestown ECO Presbyterian Church Highlights for Session Meeting, April 21, 2021

- John Mihoci reported that the Deacons organized the March Community Dinner and are planning to organize the August Community Dinner. The Deacons helped with some car expenses and also provide funds for a new set of steps to be made for a community member's house.
- Pastor Sue will be taking time off from May 13 through May 20 to help a sibling who is having surgery. She has arranged pulpit supply: May 13 Heather Harmon and May 23 Rev. Jim Weikal.
- Linda Pinney reported that we have had \$1900 donated to the Parking Lot Fund. We will designate \$500 per month from general fund to the parking lot fund, retroactive to January 2021.
- Chicken BBQ plans have been finalized. We will offer outside seating (weather permitting) as well as take-out dinners. Serving time will be from 1:00-3:00 p.m. All proceeds, after nondonated items are covered, will be designated to a youth mission trip, which will be planned and taken at a later date once the Covid restrictions have been lifted.
- Summer worship hours will begin June 6 through Labor Day (September 5). Regular worship hours will resume on September 12. No Sunday School for the summer months.
- We will continue with our current restrictions in regards to Covid-19, masking while entering and
 exiting the building and when in close contact with others. In a small group setting (such as Sunday School and committee meetings), masks are not required provided that all participants have
 been Covid-19 vaccinated and all indicate they are comfortable doing without masks. As more
 adults and children are able to be vaccinated, it is our hope that we can ease restrictions soon.
- Youth summer camp scholarships are available through the Mission Committee (information on local camps has been posted as well as His Work His Way (a local mission project). We will get information to the youth as soon as possible (see page 4 of the newsletter).
- The next Nurture meeting will be May 5 at 3:30 p.m.
- Properties, Mission and Finance meeting will be May 19 at 5:30 p.m.
- A special Session meeting will be held on May 5 at 6:00 p.m. regarding the continuing search for a qualified youth leader, and regular Session meeting on May 26 at 6:30 p.m.



Summer Worship Hours




Beginning Sunday, June 6, and continuing through Labor Day, we will observe summer worship hours.
