- D. Proverbs 3:13-16 – Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding. For she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold. She is more precious than rubies, nothing you desire can compare with her.
- E. Proverbs 21:13 – If a man shuts his ears to the cry of the poor, he too will cry out and not be answered.
- F. Proverbs 17:28 – Even a fool is thought wise if he keeps silent and discerning if he holds his tongue.
