Verses:

- A. Joshua 1:8 – Do not let this book of the law depart from your mouth, meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
- B. Psalm 34:1 – I will extol the Lord at all times, His praise will always be on my lips.
- C. 1 Thessalonians 5:11 – Therefore, encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.
- D. Matthew 5:44 – But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.
- E. Matthew 5:4 – Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- F. Matthew 7:6 – Do not give dogs what is sacred, do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under your feet, and then turn and tear you to pieces.
- G. Matthew 7:15 – Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.
