Verses:

- A. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 – ...You are not your own, you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your body.
- B. Colossians 3:13 – Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
- C. Leviticus 19:3 – Each of you must respect his mother and father, and you must observe my Sabbaths. I am the Lord your God.
- D. 1 Thessalonians 5:12 – Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you.
- E. Ephesians 4:2 – Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
