Verses:

- A. Proverbs 3:13-16 – “Blessed is the one who finds wisdom, the one who gains understanding, for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold. She is more precious than rubies, nothing you desire can compare with her. Long life is in her right hand, in her left hand are riches and honor.
- B. Proverbs 4:13 – “Hold on to instruction, do not let it go; guard it well, for it is your life.”
- C. Proverbs 15:3 – The eyes of the Lord are everywhere, keeping watch on the wicked and the good.”
- D. 1 Peter 4:10 – “Each one should use whatever gift he has been given to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.”
- E. Matthew 28:18-20 – “Then Jesus came to them and said “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
