

## Bible Application Questions – Week 19

### Verses:

- A. Psalm 119:97 – Oh, how I love your law. I meditate on it all day long.
- B. 2 Timothy 3:16 – All Scripture is God-Breathed, and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness.
- C. Jonah 3:9 – Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from His fierce anger so that we will not perish.
- D. 1 Peter 4:10 – Each one should use whatever gift he has been given to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.
- E. Ephesians 2:8-9 – For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith- and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God- not by works, so that no one can boast.
- F. Romans 12:19 – Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God’s wrath, for it is written: “It is mine to avenge, I will repay,” says the Lord.
- G. Colossians 3:23 – Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as if working for the Lord, not men.
