- D. John 14:1 – Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, trust also in Me.
- E. Isaiah 32:8 – But the noble man makes noble plans, and by noble deeds he stands.
- F. Mark 10:45 – For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many.
