

Bible Application – Week 6

Verses:

- A. Isaiah 53:5 – He was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities, the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed.
- B. Psalm 22:16 – Dogs have surrounded me, a band of evil men have encircled me, they have pierced my hands and my feet.
- C. Isaiah 53:11 – After the suffering of His soul, He will see the light of life and be satisfied, by His knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and He will bear their iniquities.
- D. Psalm 119:9 – How can a young man keep His way pure? By living according to your word.
- E. Psalm 119:11 – I have hidden your word in my heart so that I might not sin against You.
- F. Joshua 1:8 – Do not let this book of the law depart from your mouth, meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
- G. 2 Timothy 3:16 – All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness
- H. Luke 10:22 – All things have been committed to me by my Father. No one knows who the Son is except the Father and no one knows who the Father is except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him.
