

## Bible Application – Week 7

### Verses:

- A. Matthew 5:8 – Blessed are the pure in heart for they will see God.
- B. Matthew 5:9 – Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called the children of God.
- C. Matthew 5:10 – Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- D. Matthew 5:14 – You are the light of the world.
- E. Matthew 5:17 – Do not think that I’ve come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

### Questions:

- 1. We don’t offer animal sacrifices anymore, so sometimes people wonder if any of the Old Testament is relevant for today. What scripture verse shows that Jesus Christ and his word is a fulfillment of the Old Testament law? \_\_\_\_\_

- 5. You always offer a word of encouragement for those at school going through a tough time, and you point them to God. What verse from above is true of you? \_\_\_\_\_
