Verses:

- A. Philippians 4:8 – Finally brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely or admirable, if anything is excellent or praiseworthy, think about these things.
- B. John 14:1 – Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, trust also in me.
- C. Proverbs 21:1 – The king’s heart is in the hands of the Lord, He directs it like a watercourse wherever He pleases.
- D. Proverbs 3:1 – My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart.
- E. Matthew 5:23-24 – Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother, then come back and offer your gift.
- F. Matthew 18:15 – Therefore, if your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over.
- G. 2 Timothy 1:7 – For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.
