"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him."

James 1:5

The word wisdom here means more than just being smart. There are many people in our world today who have earned **multiple doctorates** and have been educated in our schools for years and years, but that does not make them wise. **Wisdom is more than intelligence and knowledge acquired.** Wisdom as it is used here means **to have spiritual understanding** and when you face trials or daily decisions, choosing to do what Jesus would do if He were faced with the same circumstances.

You see with James; wisdom has to do with applying the circumstances of life to Christian principles for living as found in the Bible.

#### Wisdom has three distinct characteristics:

<u>It is Practical</u> Intelligence sees a broken-down car and says, "This is a new car, and it should not have broken down. I am going to tear that salesman up for selling me this car and make him sorry for ever doing it." A wise person says, "It appears that the problem is mechanical and here is what I can do to fix this problem." You see, we live in a world where things brake and need to be fixed, and the practical solution is to understand that things break and focus on fixing them.

<u>It is Divine</u> God's wisdom goes beyond common sense. It might be easy to confuse common sense with wisdom, but common sense does not "count it all joy" when facing trials (James 1:2-4). The divine nature of Godly wisdom allows you to be joyful in all things.

<u>It is Christ-like</u> - Asking for wisdom is ultimately asking to be like Christ. The Bible identifies Christ as the "wisdom of God" (1 Cor. 2:1-8).

Beloved, if we are defective in wisdom, then we will not know how to handle problems when they arise. James has a solution for this: **Verse 5:"Let him ask".** If you don't have wisdom (the ability to make Christ-like decisions) then ask of God and receive, because He gives to all generously.

The key to getting wisdom is to ask God for it. 1 Kings 3:7-9\_gives us the classic example of one asking for wisdom. God heard Solomon's plea and gave him wisdom beyond anybody else in the world up to the point when Jesus came down from Heaven. (Two women with one child -1 Kings 3:28 -\_"The wisdom of God was in him")

We see this same kind of wisdom when Jesus was here walking among us. The Pharisees would set traps for Him, and He would continually reverse it on them. (Matthew 22:15-22 and John 8:1-12) Now I don't want to pass up this opportunity to be sure you understand where wisdom comes from. Where can we find the wisdom of God daily? In His word! The Bible contains hundreds of proverbs, parables, and principles that teach us the wisdom of God. If you want to be wise, then ask God for wisdom and seek His word. To ask God to make us wise and then ignore His written word is, shall we say, not wise.

uring a visit, I conversed with a gentleman about the life cycle of businesses and how important it is to revisit one's vision for that business lest one lose the focus of

why that business came to be in the first place. As we discussed this, I could not help but think of how we can apply the same idea to our lives in our upcoming revival.

The truth is we should never do anything in our lives unless we have a clear idea as to why we do it. I am currently pondering the things I do attempting to answer the question, "Why do I do them?" Some things are more important to my life than others as is reflected in why I am committed to a quiet time versus why I ride multiple miles on my bicycle. Other things impact my time investments such as "Why do I serve in Music Ministry versus why I participate with the Sayre Ministerial Alliance?"

Biblically, we should have a clear, God-given purpose for all we do. Proverbs 29:18 states, "Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, but happy is he who keeps the law." The writer here is simply saying that without a clear revelation from God, we will not know the "why's or what's" of our activities and will make decisions apart from God's guidance. This does not necessarily mean we will launch off into a life of degenerate sin, but it may mean we spend our time doing something which God does not intend for us to do which is sin as well. Consequently, we should diligently seek God for His purpose in all we set our hand to do so that we can joyfully do it to His glory. (1 Corinthians 10:31)

As we approach this revival time, consider the fact that any individual or church can be busy. We want to be busy doing things that accomplish the vision God has placed before us. Here is what our church vision statement says: First Baptist Church exists to Love God and love people by connecting them to Christ, His Word, His Community and His Mission. Are you engaged in your membership activity in such a way that we live out this vision? Do you need a revival in your vision of your life in Christ?
