


There is a sign-up sheet in the narthex for anyone who wishes to provide a meal of soup and bread for any of the Wednesdays in Lent.

From the desk of Pastor Marcia ...

We once again begin our journey toward Easter Sunday beginning with Ash Wednesday. Wednesday, March 2nd we will worship at 7 pm with Holy Communion and the



imposition of ashes on each of our foreheads. In this worship service we are reminded of our mortality. We remember that we are dust and will one day return to dust when we die to this life.

In a way each year during the season of Lent we prepare and reflect on our journey to death. We look to the Resurrection promise for each of us by worshipping and studying God's word and struggling with it all. This takes courage and work to address the reality of our mortality. In this journey we must first reckon some with the Cross of Christ before we can fully and deeply feel the depth of Jesus' sacrifice for us.

When I Survey the Wondrous Cross



The hymn, "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross" written by Isaac Watts, depicts and reminds us through his powerful words of the reality of our journey. The word survey used in this hymn can mean a somewhat more technical process but here it seems to suggest "to contemplate" or to consider what it may mean for each of us. In this we strive and hope to receive clarity on what truly matters on our journey of life and what is to come, as well as what awaits us beyond.

We will use this hymn each time we come together during our Wednesday Lenten gatherings to help center us. Using this hymn while we study God's Word as we journey together focuses us on the cross and the true meaning in it for us.

My daughter in her youth once asked me as we left our Good Friday worship service, "How does someone really understand Easter without going through Lent and Maundy Thursday and Good Friday by going to church?" A wise question that has led me to contemplate and help others to ask and consider how they may respond.

Please, consider this invitation to journey together to the cross through Lent gatherings and Worship on Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday as well as our celebration of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday. Come and explore the significance of the Cross and see why indeed Easter is the pinnacle of our faith journey.

Come and consider, "contemplate" what the cross means in your life as together we Journey through Lent.
