IN-PERSON WORSHIP UPDATE: Until we return to in-person worship, there are three opportunities to spend time with God at our church: 1) In-sanctuary worship, limited to 10 people, including our five person worship team. You must wear a mask, social distance, and wait to socialize until you get outside after the service. We can accommodate 4-5 people each week. 2) Sign up for a 30-minute time slot to pray, meditate, and spend time in the sanctuary with God, Monday through Thursday, between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. 3) We are offering outdoor gatherings of 10 people or less on the church lawn, safely distancing, for a time of worship, prayer, and fellowship. Please call Julie in the church office if you want to reserve a space on Sunday, come to pray during the week, or participate in an outdoor gathering.
