"Twin Towers" – One of the wonders of the modern world before 9/11/2001 – Became a memory in just one day... Indescribable trauma

586 B.C. – Destruction of entire city and walls of Jerusalem by Babylonians (2 Kings 25:8-10) → Uninhabited 70 years, as prophesied by Jeremiah. Almost same condition over 140 years later → Nehemiah's request to King Artaxerxes (Neh. 1:3;2:3,5)

→ Nehemiah's appeal to residents of Jerusalem and its environs. (2:17-18) Our focus today is not on Nehemiah, but those who worked, served, with him!

Despite ridicule, criticism, and plots... Neh. 2:6; 4:3 → Builders' response 4:6 – Kept on Building; 4:9 – Kept on Praying – and Watching; 4:16-18 - Wore Their Full Armor!

- Worked (not just talked) 2:18ff
- Focused (didn't work too many areas knew and played their roles) Ch. 3
- Worked Cooperatively (Ch. 3 Next to / After him; Defensive shifts Ch. 4:22), not Competitively
- Prayed to God when Threatened 4:9
- Were Prepared Had Whole Armor 4:17-18
- Sacrificed Convenience for the Goal 4:23
