



MAINTENANCE TIP OF THE MONTH

Make Your Tub Sparkle

After a few years of daily use, the minerals in water-not to mention dirt-can make any tub look stained and dingy. When this happens, don't reach for some harsh chemicals. Instead, mix up equal amounts of baking soda and cream of tartar (found in your grocery's baking section), with lemon juice until it forms a paste. Apply to stains and rub in. Then wait about an hour and rinse.
