





Riding Mower Maintenance Tip

After each use, and especially at the end of the mowing season, your mower should be properly stored. There are many people who park their mower next to their home or outside and later wonder why they are having a difficult time getting it started. It's important to keep your mower out of the elements. This prevents water and other contaminants from getting inside the mower and into parts that could damage your mower. Proper storage also decreases the number of stray animals and rodents who will find your mower a great place to live out the colder months.
