In 2018, Devine, TX had a population of 4.721 people with a median age of 37.3. Between 2017 and 2018 the population of Devine, TX grew from 4,655 to 4,721, a 1.42% increase and its median household income declined from \$58,981 to \$53,967, a -8.5% decrease.

The 5 largest ethnic groups in Devine, TX are White (Hispanic) (52.6%), White (Non-Hispanic) (36.8%), Other (Hispanic) (8.92%), Asian (Non-Hispanic) (1.21%), and Two+ (Hispanic) (0.466%). 0% of the households in Devine, TX speak a non-English language at home as their primary language, and 97.8% of the residents in Devine, TX are U.S. citizens.

The economy of Devine, TX employs 1.85k people. The largest industries in Devine, TX are Health Care & Social Assistance (334 people), Office & Administrative Support Occupations (319 people), Sales & Related Occupations (178 people), Utilities (210 people), and Retail Trade (209 people), and the highest paying industries are Mining, Quarrying, & Oil & Gas Extraction (\$92,785), Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services (\$69,250), and Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing & Hunting, & Mining (\$64,920)

COMMUTERS AVERAGE TRAVEL TIME= 28.4 minutes

Using averages, employees in Devine, TX have a longer commute time (28.4 minutes) than the normal US worker (25.3 minutes). Additionally, 1.08% of the workforce in Devine, TX have "super commutes" in excess of 90 minutes. Devine is located about 25-27 miles from mid-town San Antonio or about 30-40 minutes from the Eagle Ford Shale Oil Field south & southeast of Devine.
