


<sup>10</sup>For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption.




1 Corinthians 15:1–11



P The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the sixteenth chapter.



"Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" <sup>4</sup>And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back—it was very large. <sup>5</sup>And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. <sup>6</sup>And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. the Lord and giver of life,


who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified,

who spoke by the prophets.


