Good afternoon,

This is the latest update of what is happening at Trinity Lutheran Church, School, and Child Care

According to the latest information released by Governor Evers, the Child Care will remain open as long as possible. Please contact the Child Care directly for more information.

Also, according to the order, we can have limited services at the church. Holy Communion will be offered on Sunday morning from 8:30 am until 10:30 am. We will have to be certain to maintain distance. You will be coming into the church in groups. Approximately 9 people will be in the sanctuary and 9 people will be in the narthex. The liturgy will be spoken and then individuals will come up to the rail no more than 6 at a time to receive the sacrament. Upon dismissal from the rail, you are being asked to exit the church through the front side door so that we maintain the necessary distance. You may also receive Holy Communion by making a scheduled appointment with me. Worship services will be put on the Facebook page and YouTube channel as soon as possible.

Online Bible Class through Facebook live at approximately 10:30 am on Sunday mornings. I plan for it to run 45 minutes or less. This platform will allow you to ask questions by typing them in.
