SCRIPTURE PASSAGE

Matthew 27:44-49 NLT

ONGOING MINISTRIES


Driftwood Center is a convalescent home located in Hayward. You're invited to join a group of laymen at the center, on the **8th & 22nd** of this month at 11:00 am.

Dr. John W. Shouse

Ph.D. Southern Baptist Theological
Seminary - S.T.M. Yale University
M.Div. Yale University

Dr. John Shouse is a native of Washington, D.C. and currently chairs the Historical Theology Department at Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary where he is a Professor of Christian Theology. Dr. Shouse has served as pulpit supply and as an interim pastor at various churches and has served as an adjunct professor at educational settings around the country.

Dr. Shouse has written numerous professional papers and publications and has authored the book *An Introduction to Christian Worship*.

He is also active in the professional theater, most recently in Equity productions of William Shakespeare. Dr. Shouse is also a performing illusionist and a member of the Fellowship of Christian Magicians.
