### **The Bible Says, All Men Are Sinners!**

Our sins have separated us from God. Notice Romans 3:23 (NLT), "*For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.*" God made man in His own image. He gave us the ability to choose right from wrong. Our sinful nature separates us from God.

### **Did You Know, Our Sins Must Be Paid For?**
