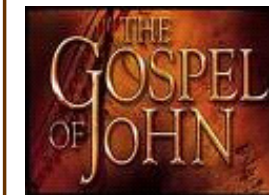

New Sermon Series Begins Next Week



Pastor Chris will begin next week a new Sunday Morning Sermon series taken from the Gospel of John. This Fourth Gospel is noted for the several "I am" sayings of Jesus. These sayings provide great insight into the purpose, position, and person of our Lord Jesus Christ.

An introductory sermon, taken from the Book of Exodus, explains the basis of the sayings. The series will conclude with an Easter message on "The King of the Jews". Each of the messages will be accompanied by a short video dramatization of the "I Am" saying taken from the Gospel of John.
