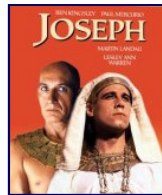

We need your help! Everyone is welcome to come and help in decorating the church for Christmas.

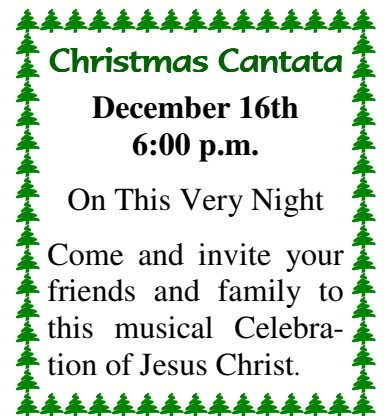
Secret Sisters Revealed
