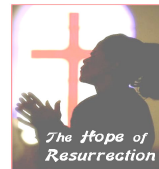

Here is a way that you can help the people in Haiti. We are asking you to help us fill 5 five gallon buckets with foodstuff. The food in a single bucket can feed a Haitian family for a week. The food items can be generic, store brand items. Do not substitute any items listed and do not add additional items. **Please sign up.** The sign up sheet in on the card table in the hallway. **The deadline will be Sunday, March 7th.**

Here are the items needed: 5 lb bag long grain enriched rice, 48 ounce plastic bottle cooking oil, 2 lb. Bag dry black beans or red beans, 5 lb. Bag of all-purpose flour (not self-rising), 1 lb box of spaghetti noodles, 2 lb 8 ounce (40 oz) plastic jar of smooth peanut butter.

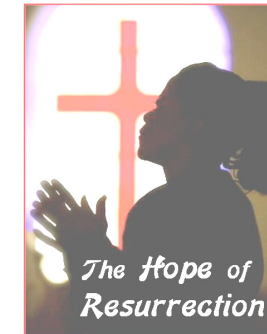
