As a Church, we find our purpose in equipping our members to live out this goal.

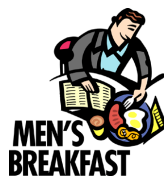


Attention those of you who are looking for an outreach into our local community. The Villa Fairmont is a near-by housing facility for adults who are not quite ready to

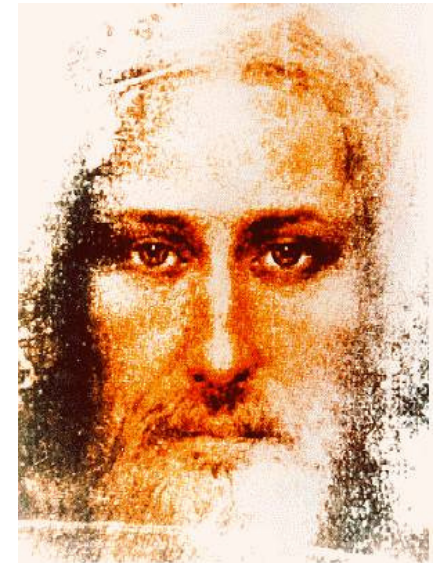
