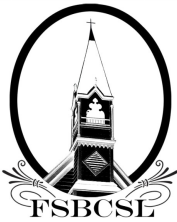
Wednesday, May 14th - There won't be any dinner or bible study. Choir practice TBA. Will resume on Wednesday, May 21st. See you then.
