As a Church, we find our purpose in equipping our members to live out this goal.



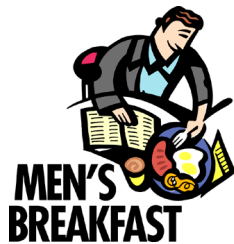
Ladies Breakfast

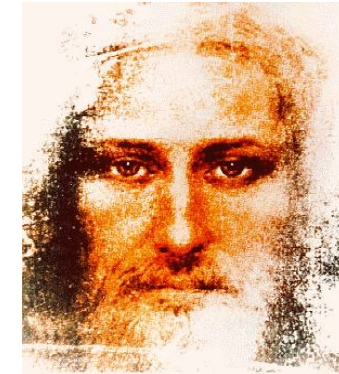
