As members of the Body of Christ, we find our purpose in:

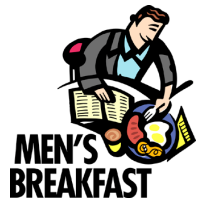

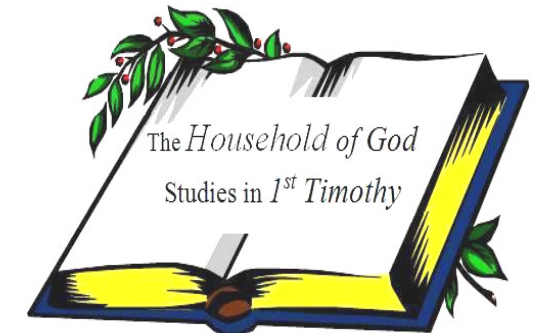
